

<sup>\*</sup>Fever: can be objective ( 100.5 F) or subjective

<sup>\*\*</sup>Symptoms include new: cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, diarrhea, respiratory distress, chills, myalgias, loss of smell, change or loss of taste sensation, new delirium or significant deterioration in functional status without other cause

<sup>\*\*\*</sup>Close contact is defined by CDC as: 1. Being within approximately 6 feet of a COVID-19 patient for a prolonged period of time (more than 5 minutes). 2. Having direct contact with infectious secretions of a COVID-19 case (e.g. being coughed on)
